

TOMPROS NIKOLAOS

Dr. Tompros Nikos (Assistant Professor of "Political History") was born in Patras in 1968. He graduated in 1992 from the History

Department of the Ionian University. He holds a PhD (2001) with distinction in the field of Modern Greek History awarded from the same department. Between 2003-2012 he taught Greek History at the Hellenic Military Academy as hourly and contract (407/80) academic personnel. In October 2012 he was elected Lecturer of "Political History" in the above mentioned Academy and in March 2019 Assistant Professor.
